## PATACS Annual Financial Report, for Fiscal Year 2017 By Paul Howard, Acting Treasurer - FY2017

PATACS's fiscal year concluded on September 30<sup>th</sup>. The Society is in excellent financial condition. Results from Operations reflects \$557.16 from operations – greater revenues than expenses.

Donations are vital to the fiscal soundness of the Society. Member generosity accounted for 33.5 percent of our income. These donations received were \$241 more than in FY 2016 Amazon commissions via our website links were \$555.90 \$47.46 more than last year.

PATACS is financially sound because of prudent planning and fiscal restraint. Membership stands at 93. Our "rainy day fund" was established many years ago. We established an additional interestbearing CD this year but interest yields on insured deposits continue to be disappointing.

Webinar Services reflects the full cost of Zoom Room Connect Service, which allows connection of the LifeSize videoconferencing equipment in Fairfax to transmit to members unable to attend in person. OPCUG is expected to reimburse \$249.50 of this expense in FY2018. Their reimbursement for this expense in FY17 is show in the Revenue section.

Our reconciled account balances within our Quicken accounting system at the close of the fiscal year (September 30th) were: Operating Checking Account \$5288.04; Cash Reserve Checking - \$9733.86; CD-F account: \$1118.50; CD-G account \$2022.63.
