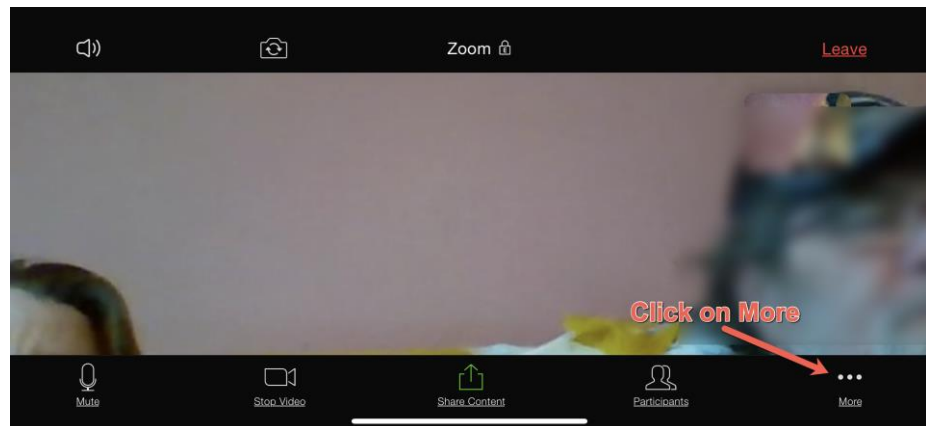


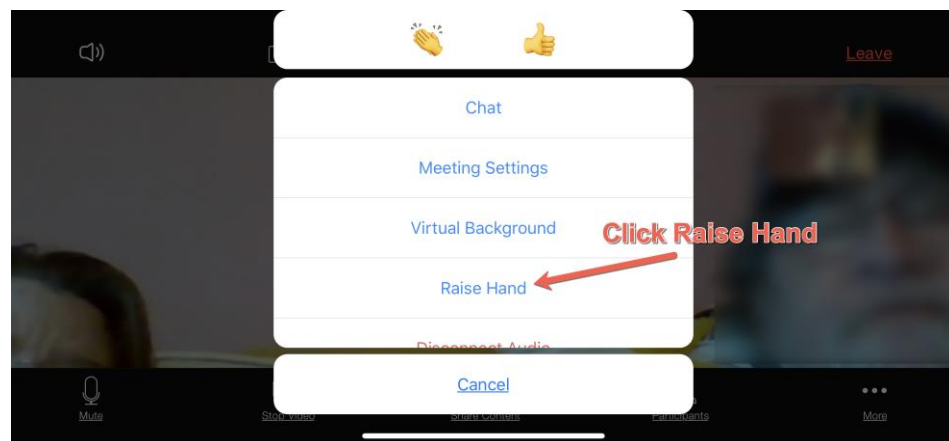
## Using Raise Hand on the iPhone

Raising the virtual hand in a Zoom webinar or meeting can be a great tool to get the attention of the session host or presenter. In a webinar, attendees do not have their faces shown since their video component isn't transmitted. The only reference of them is in the Participants panel. And in a meeting, your video may not be seen if a presenter is sharing a screen or there are more people attending than what can be viewed on the screen.

Accessing the raise hand icon is very easy. First click on the More icon at the bottom right corner of the Zoom window.



A new window will open, where you will find at the bottom of that window will be the raise hand selection. Clicking on that will put a blue hand beside your name in the Participants panel. Your name will be



moved near the top of the Participants panel, where it can be seen by the session host. If the host has not lowered your hand once you've been recognized, you can do so by clicking on the hand selection a second time. You also will notice that the text for the selection changes to lower hand.
